(Associate's, Bachelor's, and Master's Degrees)

Program review and other institutional studies depend on alumni research for information about what happens to students after graduation. Decisions at Southwestern concerning curriculum, academic support, and student services are influenced by analyses of data collected from former students.

In May 2013, 2,594 surveys were mailed to 2007 - 2013 graduates of both Weatherford and Sayre campuses. Returns numbered 231, yielding a rate of 8.91%. The 2008 response rate was 12.43%.

Few significant differences in data were noted when a comparison was made with the 2008 survey. Some of the 2013 response percentages follow:

- Alumni were asked about education, degrees, etc., that they had obtained after graduation. Forty percent responded that they had done further study, mostly toward Certification, Graduate Courses, and Licensure. The prevailing reason cited for further study continues to be for "career advancement," which jumped 9 to 17 percentage points over the last five and ten years.
- Seven percent of respondents are currently not employed. Seventy percent are employed in the area that they studied at Southwestern, and 96% still use the knowledge and skills gained in their area.
- Almost 15% of the respondents reported that if they had it to do over, they would take additional courses related to Spanish. Eight to nine percent desired more Business knowledge in Accounting, Management, Finance, and/or Business Administration. Six to seven percent were also interested in Nursing and/or Psychology course work.
- Faculty in the students' major areas served as academic advisors to almost 66% of the respondents. The "self-advised" approximated 18%.
- Fifty-eight percent were members of a club and/or social organization while at Southwestern. However, only 19% are currently members of the Southwestern Alumni Association. This is down by 6%.

- Ninety-four percent of Southwestern graduates reported that they considered their investment in the university to be worthwhile.
- Views of academic quality ranked 1.76 on a scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being a “high” satisfaction level. This is about the same as last year. Alumni respondents are mostly satisfied with both education (1.56) and faculty (1.53) in major area. The quality of overall education received a score of 1.57. The quality of education received in the general education area also seems to have been better received compared to respondents from five and 10 years ago. This year’s score was 1.86 compared to 2.06 and 2.28 respectively. General Education faculty were also rated better with a score of 1.81 this time compared to 2.04 and 2.27 over the previous five and ten years. Improvement touched grading standards as well.
- The rating regarding the quality of physical facilities and equipment at Southwestern has improved to 1.88 from 2.16 in 2008 and 2.50 in 2003. The Southwestern community is proud of the consistent effort to make both useful and cosmetic improvements.
- Services by the Registrar’s Office, Business Office, Financial Aid Office, Library, and Dean of Students were well received as evidenced by scores of 1.63 – 1.78.
- Demographic points of interest follow:

All respondents are U.S. citizens, 87% being White/Caucasian and almost 5% being American Indian. Seventy percent are female and thirty percent are male. Well over half of those replying are between the ages of 22 and 27. The ages of another 31% are between 28 and 40. The GPA of 88% of the respondents is above a 3.0 and, generally, half of the respondents’ current salaries are above \$40,000 annually.

Following is a summary report of data. The number of responses for each item varies since not all graduates responded to each item, and some items allowed more than one response. Analyses use the number of responses per item.
